Love A Child, Give a Gift

Dear FMSC Friend,

Hungry, they stand on the tops of mountains watching...

When the food trucks bearing Feed My Starving Children's Manna-Packs come rumbling around the corner, the Haitian children jump up and down, clap their hands, and sing "ti pa nou, ti pa nou"—a little for us.

Feed My Starving Children has an amazing mission partner near Fond Parisien, Haiti. Called Love a Child (LAC), this partner feeds some 5,000 hungry children each day. Love a Child uses **FMSC food to operate an orphanage; 14 schools; the Jesus Healing Center malnourishment clinic; Miracle Village, a "city" of 500 new homes for victims of the 2010 earthquake ; and a food distribution warehouse that supplies 42 other missions and charities all across Haiti.**

Food isn't always *delivered* to the hungry though. Sometimes the hungry are brought to LAC. A few months after Ericka was born, her mother died and her father left. Abandoned, Ericka was malnourished and suffering from a severe skin infection. A neighbor wrapped the baby girl in a dirty blanket and carried her to Love a Child—a place she had heard was a refuge.

"As I unwrapped the blanket, I saw what hunger and malnutrition does," recalls Sherry Burnette, who founded LAC with her husband Bobby in 1995. "It brings pain and torture to tiny little human beings who God loves. It takes dignity, health, and hope, and brings pain and death." With time, attention, and FMSC food though, Ericka began to gain weight. Although her malnutrition was so severe, it caused permanent brain damage, she is now in "Kindergarten 2" at LAC's school.

"She is talking more and walking better, but the best thing is that Ericka is funny, giggly, and one of the happiest children I have ever seen," says Burnette.

Won't you help children like Ericka, by helping us provide food to fuel Love a Child in Haiti? Ericka is just one of the very hungry Haitian children whom we can give a second chance through partners like LAC who move families forward.

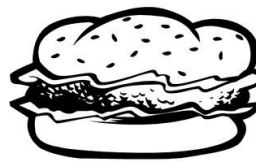

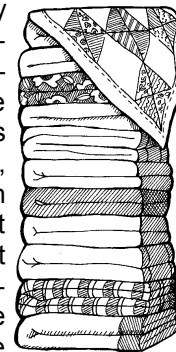
